## Type of Tournament

This is a six-team bracket in which the top two seeds have byes into the WCD3 Tournament and the quarterfinal matchups are Nisqually League Play-in (elimination) games to be played on Tuesday, November 1<sup>st</sup> at home site locations. The semifinal games signify the start of the WCD3 tournament are not elimination games as the tournament is a double-elimination from Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> on. The final four teams will compete for two allocations into the 1A WIAA State Volleyball Tournament. The WCD3 semifinal matchups on Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> will be played at home sites. The final three matches of the WCD3 Tournament will be played at Cascade Christian High School on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> with scheduled start times of 11:00am, 1:00pm and 3:00pm. Once a final four team loses twice, they are eliminated from contention for one of the two births to State. - \$4.00—Military
- Free—Pre-school (5 and under)

### Program Roster Information:

- All school's need to use WPAN's Roster Center to generate their school roster. Please "Create PDF" for both:
  - "District Program Half Page"
  - "District Program Full Page"
- Teams advancing to the 1A WIAA State Tournament will need to follow WIAA instructions on how to share their roster for that tournament the following week.

### Team Entry:

Each team may have a roster of 14 players and 6 other individuals serving as coaches/managers/statisticians. Schools with an athletic trainer/medical professional are allowed one additional person on the bench. This person is not allowed to coach in any capacity. No one other than those listed on the official roster are allowed on the playing floor or the team bench. All players/coaches/managers should enter together through the main gym entrance.

### Passes:

League and season passes will not be honored. WSSAAA passes are accepted. WSCA passes are excepted. WCD Executive Board passes are accepted.

### Gate Pass List:

- Administrators or faculty only on the supervision gate pass list will be admitted for free.
- This pass list should be emailed to DJ Heltsley ([HeltsleyD@cascadechristian.org](mailto:HeltsleyD@cascadechristian.org)), Tournament Director, by Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup> in order to be utilized at the matches on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>. Pass list for quarterfinal or semifinal matches should be emailed to the home site athletic directors the day before those matches.
- Supervisors whose names are on the pass list are asked to remain near their student section and to help maintain a sportsmanlike atmosphere.

### Team Introductions:

- Quarterfinal and semifinal matches will be introduced at the discretion of host sites, as communicated by the host athletic director prior to the match.
- For all three matches on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, the Tournament Director will announce all players and coaches as listed on their provided WPAN generated District Program roster.

### Officials and Scorers:

Tacoma-Pierce County and Seattle volleyball officials associations will be partnering to cover all officials and scorers positions—game officials, line judges, score keeper and libero tracker. The West Central District III is covering the cost of these officials. Officials should not leave until their replacements have arrived.

## Game Balls:

Coaches and officials shall agree upon the game balls to be used in any given match of the tournament.

## Pre-Match Warm-Up:

The official warm up will use the 8-6-6 format. Eight minutes of shared time, six minutes for home team, and six minutes for the visiting team. The home team will warm up first. If a team plays back-to-back, they will have at least 20 minutes of rest prior to the captains meeting for the second consecutive match.

## Designation of Home Team:

The home team will be the bottom team of each bracket match-up, except for game #7. In game #7, the home team will be the loser of game #5.

## Athletic Training/Medical Assistance:

Each team should provide their own athletic trainer and supplies, as needed or desired. On Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, Cascade Christian ATC Shelby Parthemer will be on site to handle any medical emergencies. There will also be ice and access to a training room available upon request of the Tournament Director.

## Locker Rooms:

For Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, classrooms adjacent to the gym will be assigned to each participating school to be utilized as that team's personal "locker room." You will have the ability to keep this room locked while you are not using it. Arrangements for quarterfinal and semifinal matchups should be discussed with the hosting school's athletic director.

## Cheerleaders:

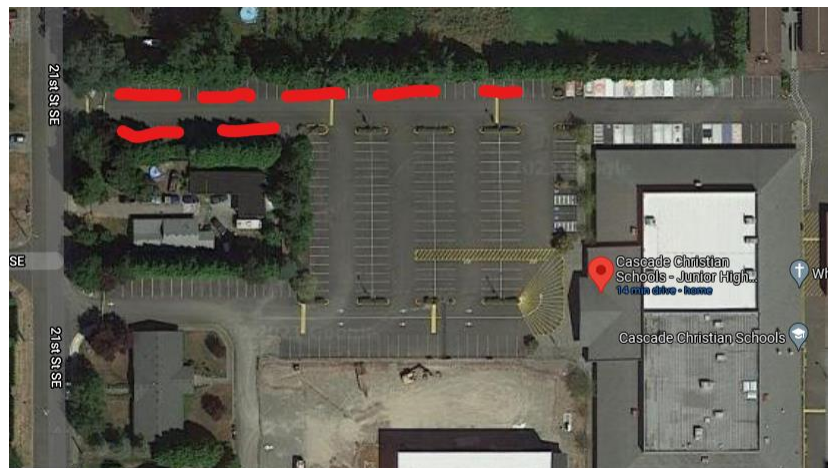
Admitted for free only if in official uniform and must remain in designated areas under the supervision of the cheer coach/advisor.

## Game Film and Stream:

For Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, there are electrical outlets available in the gym to charge batteries, if needed. All matches will be streamed on NFHS and a link to the video can be available on demand if requested of the Tournament Director the day after the match.

## Buses and Vans:

For Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, team buses and vans should drop off their participants at the front main entrance of the school and then proceed to park along the northern boundary of the parking lot, as indicated by the **RED** lines drawn on the map below:



## Spectator Parking:

For Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, parking will be available for spectators in the main lot at Cascade Christian High School. Handicap parking will be available in the front of the building.

## General Statements:

- The official school banner will be the only sign permitted to be held or hung in the gym.
- Any artificial noisemakers are prohibited and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors.
- The throwing of confetti or any other materials is not allowed.

## Concessions:

For Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, concessions will be sold in the concession area outside the gym. Water bottle filling is available for free in the hallway outside the gym.
