

#### Game Balls

#### Officials

The Assigning Secretary for the District that hosts the event will assign the officials for the contest. The assignors will post contests on the arbiter platform.

#### **Passes**

#### **Roster Size**

Roster sizes will match the roster sizes for the state tournament for each sport.

#### Schedule Changes

Any game, match, meet changes will be authorized by the District Directors or their designee. Common League opponents in the brackets can entertain a home game option with approval by directors and principals of each school. Considerations include transportation and RPI for venue selection.

#### Seeding Committee

A seeding committee will be used to place teams into tournaments. The seeding committee shall have the following 9 members:

- 1 League President from each of the 3 leagues
- 1 Sport Commissioner from each of the 3 leagues
- 1 coach from each league appointed by the Sport Commissioner of each league

We will follow the guiding principles of our district directors and WIAA convictions as our standard of care inside these matters. The brackets have been updated and agreed upon and approved by District Directors. This is not up for discussion today.

Remaining league allocations (SPSL 4, OLY- 3, KingCo- 3), plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations will be determined by a Seeding Committee as well. (These are earned)

Seeding Committee Selection process and data points/tools that the committee will use to seed teams will be included in a separate document.

The Seeding Committee members agree to set the bracket with clear competitive opponents. (league opponents will impasse at times.) With considerations to RPI while avoiding league match ups in the 1st round of 9-16. We will not avoid league match ups inside the rank of 1-8 where the schools land in the seeding discussion. The Seeding Committee Selection will remain confidential as these decisions will be final upon this agreement. The Seeding Committee will post the final bracket on the district websites at the conclusion of the meeting for the

Assigning of the officials.

#### **Sport Commissioner**

Each league will designate a sport commissioner for each sport. The Commissioner shall attend sport specific meeting(s).

  - The District Director(s) will review the waivers merit, visit the site(s) and determine where the game will be played no later than three (3) days prior to the contest.
