Re-entry: No re-entry allowed.

Passes: Only WCD Authorized passes, WCD Sponsor passes, WSCA (Coaches Association) passes, and WSSAAA (A.D. Association) passes will be honored!!! School District, League, WIAA, WOA, etc. will not be accepted.

Pass Gate Lists: Athletic Directors need to submit pass gate lists via **email to Jlee4@tacoma.k12.wa.us before 3:00pm on Thursday February 15th.**

Signage: No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.

Concessions: No Concessions

Practice: No practice at the game site prior to and during the tournament unless it is a normal practice for the home site school and ends an hour and a half prior to the first posted game time.

Locker Rooms: Assignment of Lockers will be made on the day of the game at venue

Trainer / Taping: An athletic trainer will be on site. Each team is responsible for its own tape and supplies.

Alcoholic Beverages: Not allowed on campus

Smoking: Smoking, to include vaping and all other tobacco products is prohibited on Tacoma Public School property. This includes bathrooms and parking lots.

Court Floor: Only players, coaches, officials, and Tournament staff are allowed on the floor of the court. It is the supervisor's responsibility to monitor their student section and keep students/fans off the basketball court.

Video: Designated areas for videotaping is only available to teams in the upper deck. This availability is subject to space and spectator capability to view the game. Spectators will be given priority if viewing is obstructed.

Masks: Masks must be properly (over both nose and mouth) worn at all times while on Tacoma Public School property. Failure to wear a mask or do so properly will lead the individual to be subject to dismissal from the facility.

Confetti: Confetti is not allowed. Schools violating this rule will be subject to clean up costs.

Balloons: Not allowed

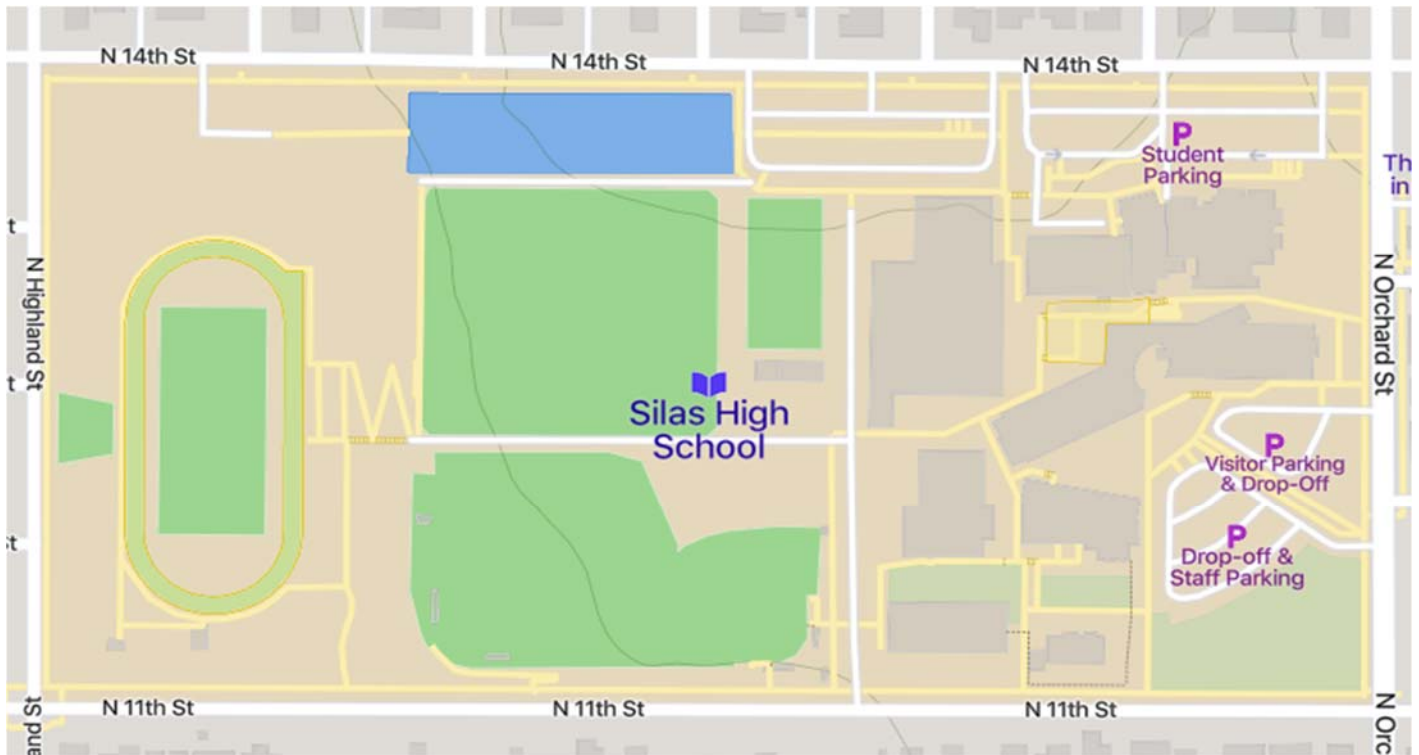
Selfie Sticks: Not allowed

Noisemakers: Artificial noisemakers of any kind are not allowed. Noisemakers will be subject to confiscation by the staff.

Crowd Control: Participating schools will be responsible for supervising their respective students and fans. School supervisors are expected to wear badges and sit in their student section during the game. Supervisors are responsible for the proper wearing of masks, crowd behavior to include name calling, heckling, taunting, offensive slurs, and other offensive behavior directed towards the opposing team, the officials, and the staff.

Band/Cheer/Dance/Drill Teams: Team members in uniform will be admitted free along with their advisor. They will perform in designated areas only. For example, cheer will cheer in designated areas on the court, band will occupy the upper deck. Prior notice (before the game) must be given if a team wants to perform at halftime

Band equipment will not be allowed to set up in an aisle, aisles must be clear. If you desire electricity, you will need to bring your own extension cord. There is no guarantee that electricity may be available. If you are using pre-recorded music, you will need to bring your apparatus to play this music from.



Events Involving Harry Bird Memorial Gymnasium

Events such as Basketball (Boys and Girls) and Volleyball are played at Harry Bird Memorial Gymnasium. To locate the gymnasium, take a left hand turn from North Orchard Street onto North 14th Street. Roughly a block down, you will see a large parking lot to your left. Access to the gymnasium is on the east side of the Silas Swimming Pool.
